## We Did It!!

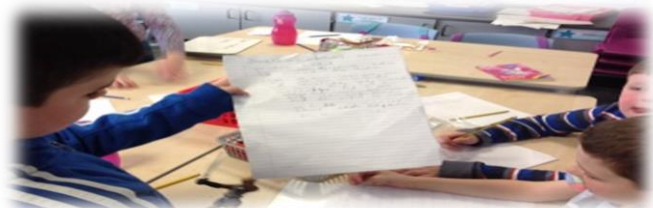
We are absolutely delighted to announce we achieved our Level 2 Award in June. We had super feedback from our Assessors.

We have formed our new committee this year and are all looking forward to continuing the good work we worked on last year as we were engaged in our Level 2 Award and Assessment.

We are continuing to collect money in our JAM tins for our sponsored children in Diesploit, Africa. We have given our new primary ones and some of our new pupils a JAM tin now and would love if the whole school could continue to help us feed and educate them. For just £3 a month we can continue to give these children food, care and shelter. Our aim is to continue to send £66 each month to support them.



We are also continuing to support our Ugandan orphans. We are enjoying writing to them all and have received lovely letters for them. We split our recipe book money between our sponsored children and them. We have now sent £500 so far.





We had a fantastic sustainability fortnight in June.

We upcycled clothing, made wind chimes, planted flowers to encourage wildlife, made bug hotels, planted vegetables. We also had a magnificent doorstep challenge when we grew vegetables in all sorts of strange and unique containers.



We printed and sold our economical recipe book and raised £178 for our African friends.
