Phonics and Spelling—We will continue to work through Primary two sounds and will spend lots of time reinforcing these during literacy lessons. Our spelling tasks will be mainly active and weekly common words will be a suggested homework task. Don't forget that these will be assessed during our spelling.

This term we are going to focus staying safe in the dark along with firework safety. We will also be looking at cleanliness and hygiene and how to take care of ourselves by keeping clean and cleaning our teeth.

Our PE days and times will be: **Mondays and Wednesdays**


Gym kits are required for these days and should include a polo shirt or t-shirt, shorts and a pair of gym shoes or trainers.
