Literacy



Reading -Through our group reading books, we will be applying higher order thinking skills to answering questions, as well as looking at characters, setting and main events. We also visit the school library each Friday to select a book to read after lunchtime each day.

Numeracy & Maths

During term 2 we are planning to cover:

- * 2D and 3D shape
- * Multiplication and Division
- * Fractions

Throughout daily mental maths sessions we will focus on the 4 operations, improving speed and accuracy. We use a combination of Big Maths, Number Talks and Maths Mastery approaches to deliver mental maths lessons. For further challenge, pupils will explore more problem-solving based tasks.
