Term 2



Numeracy & Maths

During Term 2 we are planning to cover:

- * Addition
- * Money
- * Symmetry

We will be utilising both the classroom and outdoor spaces where possible to support and extend learning.

We will also continue our daily Big Maths sessions throughout this term. During these, we will focus on number doubles to 5, number halves to 10 and basic addition 'Learn Its' (E.g. 2+1, 2+3...)



Reading – In class, your child is working on 2 reading book per week, alongside completing relevant comprehension tasks. Due to Covid we unfortunately cannot send books home. Therefore, we will continue to focus on the 3 Read Approach at home. Please see the 3 Read Approach Guidance Sheet in your Home Learning Pack if you wish to continue to develop your child's skills at home.

Phonics – We learn our first sound on a Monday, consolidate first sound on a Tuesday, learn our second sound on a Thursday and consolidate second sound on a Friday. Please feel free to make up your own sound flashcards to suit the new sounds that we are learning.

Writing – Our Big Writing day is on a Wednesday. During this session, pupils will learn to share their story using their own words to a teacher who will 'write what they say' and will write over/under our writing, or copy from a whiteboard. This will later progress onto "having a go" at sounding out words on their own.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we will finish our Autumn Topic and finally we will move on to our Nativity. During our Autumn Topic we have learned about many different animals, signs of Autumn and hibernation.

Lastly, we will commence our Nativity preparations. This will look very different to previous years but we hope it will still be just as much fun for us all! More information to follow ☺
